Our weekly programming is anchored by Sunday Morning Bible Study using curriculum from Lifeway called The Gospel Project. This curriculum studies the Bible from Genesis through Revelation every three years. If a student is with us from 6<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> grade they will go through the Bible more than twice. A rotation of seniors cover the opening announcements each week, after which we break into classes.







- •to send out our youth, not simply draw others in







# The Doctrine of Sin and Death

Romans 1:16-17 <sup>16</sup> I am not ashamed of the gospel, because it is the power of God for the salvation of everyone who believes: first for the Jew, then for the Gentile.<sup>17</sup> For in the gospel a righteousness from God is revealed, a righteousness that is by faith from first to last, just as it is written: "The righteous will live by faith."

**ROMANS 1:18-25** <sup>18</sup> For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of people who suppress the truth <sup>[m]</sup>in unrighteousness, <sup>19</sup> because that which is known about God is evident <sup>[m]</sup>within them; for God made it evident to them. <sup>20</sup> For since the creation of the world His invisible *attributes, that is*, His eternal power and divine nature, have been clearly perceived, being understood by what has been made, so that they are without excuse. <sup>21</sup> For even though they knew God, they did not <sup>[m]</sup>honor Him as God or give thanks, but they became futile in their reasonings, and their senseless hearts were darkened. <sup>22</sup> Claiming to be wise, they became fools, <sup>23</sup> and they exchanged the glory of the incorruptible God for an image in the form of corruptible mankind, of birds, four-footed animals, and <sup>[m]</sup>crawling creatures.

<sup>24</sup> Therefore God gave them up to vile impurity in the lusts of their hearts, so that their bodies would be dishonored among them. <sup>25</sup> For they exchanged the truth of God for <sup>[a]</sup> falsehood, and worshiped and served the creature rather than the Creator, who is blessed <sup>[a]</sup> forever. Amen.

**ROMANS 3:9-20** 9 What then? Are we better *than they*? Not at all; for we have already charged that both Jews and Greeks are all under sin; <sup>10</sup> as it is written:

11 There is no one who understands,

12 They have all turned aside, together they have become **Corrupt;
There is no one who does good,
There is not even one."

13 "Their throat is an open grave,
With their tongues they keep deceiving,"

"The venom of **Dasps is under their lips";

14 "Their mouth is full of cursing and bitterness";

15 "Their feet are swift to shed blood,

16 Destruction and misery are in their paths,

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<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>19</sup> Now we know that whatever the Law says, it speaks to those who are <sup>k</sup>under the Law, so that every mouth may be closed and all the world may become accountable to God; <sup>20</sup> because by the works <sup>ll</sup>of the Law <sup>lm</sup>none of mankind will be justified in His sight; for <sup>ln</sup>through the Law *comes* <sup>ln</sup>knowledge of sin.

### **ROMANS 5:12-14**

<sup>12</sup> Therefore, just as through one man sin entered into the world, and death through sin, and so death spread to all mankind, because all sinned— <sup>13</sup> for huntil the Law sin was in the world, but sin is not how counted against *anyone* when there is no law. <sup>14</sup> Nevertheless death reigned from Adam until Moses, even over those who had not sinned in the likeness of the hiviolation *committed* by Adam, who is a huntil who was to come.

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WHAT DOES SPIRITUAL DEATH IMPLY ABOUT OUR NEED FOR SALVATION?

**ROMANS 7:18–25** <sup>18</sup> For I know that good does not dwell in me, that is, in my flesh; for the willing is present in me, but the doing of the good *is* not. <sup>19</sup> For the good that I want, I do not do, but I practice the very evil that I do not want. <sup>20</sup> But if I do the very thing I do not want, I am no longer *the one* doing it, but sin that dwells in me.

If find then the <sup>[1]</sup>principle that evil is present in me, the one who wants to do good. <sup>22</sup> For I joyfully agree with the law of God <sup>[2]</sup> In the inner person, <sup>23</sup> but I see a different law in <sup>[3]</sup> the parts of my body waging war against the law of my mind, and making me a prisoner <sup>[3]</sup> of the law of sin, *the law* which is in <sup>[3]</sup> my body's parts. <sup>24</sup> Wretched man that I am! Who will set me free from <sup>[3]</sup> the body of this death? <sup>25</sup> Thanks be to God through Jesus Christ our Lord! So then, on the one hand I myself with my mind am serving the law of God, but on the other, with my flesh the law of sin.

**ROMANS 8:1-11** Therefore there is now no condemnation at all for those who are in Christ Jesus. <sup>2</sup> For the law of the Spirit of life [2]in Christ Jesus has set you free from the law of sin and of death. <sup>3</sup> For what the Law could not do, [aa]weak as it was through the flesh, God *did*: sending His own Son in the likeness of [ab]sinful flesh and *as an offering* for sin, He condemned sin in the flesh, <sup>4</sup> so that the requirement of the Law might be fulfilled in us who do not walk [ac]according to the flesh but [ad]according to the Spirit. <sup>5</sup> For those who are in accord with the flesh set their minds on the things of the flesh, but those who are in accord with the Spirit, the things of the Spirit. <sup>6</sup> For the mind [ae]set on the flesh is death, but the mind [af]set on the Spirit is life and peace, <sup>7</sup> because the mind [ag]set on the flesh is hostile toward God; for it does not subject itself to the law of God, for it is not even able *to do so*, <sup>8</sup> and those who are in the flesh cannot please God.

<sup>9</sup> However, you are not in the flesh but in the Spirit, if indeed the Spirit of God dwells in you. But if anyone does not have the Spirit of Christ, he does not belong to Him. <sup>10</sup> If Christ is in you, though the body is dead because of sin, yet the spirit is [ah] alive because of righteousness. <sup>11</sup> But if the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, He who raised Christ Jesus from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies [ai] through His Spirit who dwells in you.
