DEATH AND BIRTH NOTICES

As part of the new strategic plan, we will begin notifying the congregation of the death of church members and the birth of babies with their family's permission. We ask that you subscribe to these notices by email. We'll continue to communicate to family members and extended family by the prayer list and through SMBS classes and normal channels of communication.

When a church member or attender dies, Pastoral staff will contact family and ask for their permission to publish information to the church. Information will contain a link to the obituary and information about service times. Email will be distributed when service times are confirmed or within 48 hours of the contact (whichever comes first).

Members and friends of First Baptist may call the information into the church and may distribute info to their SMBS groups and email lists. However, only members of immediate family have permission to ask the church to send out churchwide death notices.
