CHRISTMAS WORK BEGINS

Happy New Year! As we begin 2016 together, I want to tell you how grateful I am to be a part of such a wonderful church. Thank you for encouraging me with your prayers, participation, and presence throughout the Advent Season. As I shared Sunday, the work of Christmas begins now. Let me share how you can help at First Baptist.

Beginning Sunday, I'll be preaching a series of sermons on 1 Peter entitled "Strong Homes." First Peter is written to believers scattered in places where they serve under the leadership of nonbelievers. How are they to behave at home, work, and in society when the people in authority over them are disobedient? This book instructs us to be a royal priesthood, a holy nation. Our conduct sets us apart, and we demonstrate that through our hope, respect, obedience, gentleness, reverence, and care for those around us. Join us each Sunday for worship.

On Wednesday night, I start a new series through the book of Exodus entitled, "Questions Children Ask." It's based on two important passages in Exodus 10:2 and 12:26. Children and grandchildren ask, "What do these things mean?" Exodus is written to people who wonder and worry if their grandchildren will share their faith—or have any faith at all. As we seek to build strong homes as a church, Exodus teaches how to explain God's power and deliverance so that future generations will know and believe in the living God. Join us on Wednesday nights as we study God's work in Exodus and learn to share our faith across the generations.

Lastly, I want you to know how much I appreciate Zach and Shelley Allen. Zach has ministered personally to our family and has been a great blessing to our college students and the campuses in Tallahassee. As you'll read in another section of this newsletter, Zach has accepted a call to City Church in a similar role. His last Sunday with us will be January 10, and we'll have a reception for the Allens from 11:00AM - 1:00PM. Our personnel committee will meet to discuss an interim college minister and to plan with our college leadership team for the future. Please pray for Zach and Shelley in this new work. We will miss them.
